
Heart Attack = Myocardial Infarction

1. Plaque accumulates


 chronic buildup of porridgelike fats-atherosclerosis

2. Plaque ruptures


- rapid formation of a thrombus or blood clot
- **Blood supply stops**
- 7. Muscle dies













<u>Ejection</u> Fraction

<u>What it Means</u>

- 50 70% Normal
- 36 49% Below Normal
- 35 40% May confirm diagnosis of systolic heart failure
- < 35% Patient may be at risk of life-threatening irregular heartbeats

30% death"!




Age-adjusted death rates for CHD, stroke, lung and breast for white and black females (United States: 2004). Source: NCHS and NHLBI.





